

SOME TAKE-AWAYS FROM THE TRINITY By Fr. John Cuff

The Trinitarian relationship of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, in such a way that each is fully and equally God, and yet there are not three Gods but one, cannot be fully comprehended by the human mind; it's a mystery. But though we're not able to grasp the **how** of the Trinity, it might be helpful to ask about the **why:** Why does God reveal to us the nature of the Supreme Being if we can't understand it? Perhaps the importance of the doctrine lies in the fact that we are made in the image of God, and therefore the more we understand about God, the more we understand ourselves.

Experts in religion tell us that people tend to be like the god they worship. People who worship a warrior god tend to be warmongering, people who worship a god of pleasure tend to be pleasure-seeking, people who worship a god of wrath tend to be vengeful, and people who worship a god of love tend to be loving. Like the god, so the worshippers. So the guestion we might ask today is: What does the doctrine of the Trinity tell us of the kind of God we worship, and what does this say about the kind of people we should be? Two points emerge: First of all, God does not exist in solitary individualism but in a community of love and sharing. In other words, God is not a loner, which means that a Christian in search of Godliness must shun every tendency to isolationism and selfish individualism. Ideal Christian spirituality is not one of flight from the world, like some Buddhist monastic traditions, where the quest for holiness may mean permanent withdrawal to the Himalayas to seek nirvana, thus avoiding contact and involvement with people and society. Rather it tends to be incarnational, getting involved with the world.

Secondly, love often involves three partners. We've all heard the saying, "Two's company, three's a crowd." However, the Trinity suggests that three is not a crowd, it's a community; three is love at its best. Take an example from the human condition: when man A is in love with woman B, they often seal their love by producing baby C. So, father, mother and child – even in the natural realm of the family, love, when perfected, becomes a trinity. After all, we're made in God's image and likeness. Just as God is God only in a Trinitarian relationship, so we become fully human only in a relationship of three partners. One's self needs to be in a horizontal relationship with others and in a vertical relationship with God. In this way our life becomes Trinitarian, like that of God. So the principle of unbridled individualism, so popular and acceptable in modern society, is out. This is what Trinity can teach us today. The doctrine of the Trinity challenges us to adopt rather an I-and-Godand-neighbor principle. I'm a true Christian insofar as I live in a relationship of love with God and other people. May the grace of the Blessed Trinity help us to banish all self-centeredness, and to live in love of God and of neighbor.






