Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Many Catholics have strong devotion of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, whose feast was this last Friday. The following information is an excerpt from this link: [Why is June the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus? – EWTN Global Catholic Television Network](#)

The Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus dates back to 1673, when a French nun who belonged to the Order of the Visitation of Holy Mary (Visitandines) in eastern France began to receive visions about the Sacred Heart.

Jesus appeared to Sister Margaret Mary Alacoque and revealed ways to venerate his Sacred Heart and explained the immense love he has for humanity, appearing with his heart visible outside his chest, on fire, and surrounded by a crown of thorns.

Jesus told Sister Margaret Mary: "My Sacred Heart is so intense in its love for men, and for you in particular, that not being able to contain within it the flames of its ardent charity, they must be transmitted through all means."

He said: "I ask of you that the Friday after the octave of Corpus Christi be set apart for a special feast to honor my heart, by communicating on that day, and making reparation to it by a solemn act, in order to make amends for the indignities which it has received during the time it has been exposed on the altars. I promise you that my heart shall expand itself to shed in abundance the influence of its divine love upon those who shall thus honor it, and cause it to be honored."

These are the promises the Sacred Heart of Jesus made to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque:

- 1 – I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
- 2 – I will give peace in their families.
- 3 – I will console them in all their troubles.
- 4 – I will be their refuge in life and especially in death.
- 5 – I will abundantly bless all their undertakings.
- 6 – Sinners shall find in my heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7 – Tepid souls shall become fervent.
- 8 – Fervent souls shall rise speedily to great perfection.
- 9 – I will bless those places wherein the image of my Sacred Heart shall be exposed and venerated.
- 10 – I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.
- 11 – Persons who propagate this devotion shall have their names eternally written in my heart.
- 12 – In the excess of the mercy of my heart, I promise you that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the first Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.

JESUS' EXTENDED FAMILY

Mark's Gospel, which we read during Year B, records nothing of Jesus' infancy or childhood. He introduces Jesus as a grown man, but one who's already become a bit of an enigma to relatives in Nazareth. With his father Joseph gone, Jesus is now a thirty-year-old who must make his own decisions in life, but the decisions he makes seem so out of synch with his extended family that they're frankly worried about his sanity. The Gospel tells us quite bluntly that Jesus' brothers, that is, his cousins, did not quite know what to make of him. Hearing of his increasingly strange behavior, like his not having enough time to eat, was the last straw. They decide to take action; and so "They set out to seize him, for they said, 'He is out of his mind.'"

The hostile reaction of Jesus' relatives was not only because he was neglecting to take care of his health, his nourishment, and his rest, but also because of his choice of lifestyle. They expected him to carry on Joseph's occupation as a carpenter, marry and raise a family, and care for his widowed mother. But Jesus instead seems to have chosen the life of a wandering preacher. Moreover, he seems to prefer other people to be like his close family---a band of 12 disciples he calls Apostles, chiefly a ragged group of unlettered fisherman and others of dubious character, like the tax-collector Matthew and the revolutionary Simon the Zealot. Thus, Jesus' strange behavior was a major cause of concern for his family and those close to him. In any event, today's Gospel records Jesus' family coming to grab him while he's teaching and to take him home. Jesus refuses to meet them for two reasons: first, he knows they want to seize him and take him back to Nazareth, and he was having none of that. Second, maybe because he sees this as a teachable moment for all concerned, both his family and his disciples. And so, when told that his mother and his brothers were outside asking for him, he replies, "Who are my mother and my brothers?" and looking around at those seated in the circle he said, "Here are my mother and my brothers; whoever does the will of God is brother and sister and mother to me."

This saying is a revelation to all concerned including ourselves. Jesus is pointing to a new bond of family relationship that goes beyond blood relationship. He's saying his true mother and brothers are those who do the will of God, for it is faith that makes us his brothers and sisters. Do we ever feel a little envious of Mary, Joseph, and other so-called brothers of Jesus, because they were privileged to belong to Jesus' very own family? Well, there's good news for us in Mark's Gospel: we are as privileged as they were. Anyone who does the will of God is indeed brother, sister, and mother to him. By obedience to God's will, we receive kinship with Christ. But we are not to keep this privilege to ourselves. Rather, we are to share this privilege with others, inviting them to be his brothers and sisters by keeping his Father's will.

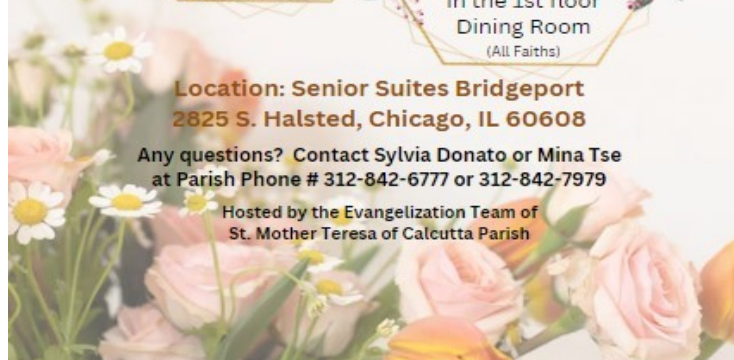

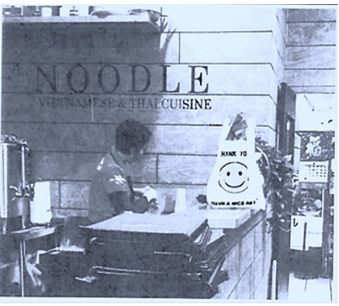
