Dear St. Therese families and friends,

At this time, we want to share with you that St. Therese Chinese Catholic School, the Chicago Archdiocese and administrators from De La Salle Institute have reached an impasse in their negotiations to take over the lease at the De La Salle Lourdes Campus in Bridgeport. Despite the most diligent and earnest efforts to make our dream of expanding to a second campus this fall a reality, negotiations on important terms and conditions were not reached in time to open doors for a second campus for the fall of 2017.

There is a Chinese proverb that states, "A setback may turn out to be a blessing in disguise." We firmly believe that God has guided our school for many years. We continue to feel strongly that things happen for a reason and that reason will become clearer to us in the near future. We want to assure you that St. Therese, together with the Archdiocese, will continue to look for and evaluate various sites to support our desired growth to a second campus, with particular emphasis on previously occupied Archdiocesan buildings.

We are disappointed that the long list of students and families eager to be a part of the St. Therese experience will not have that opportunity this fall. However, we remain strongly committed to meeting this demand as soon as possible.

Our school remains committed to continuously improving the educational experience for our current students and families at the Chinatown campus. Among the improvements planned for 2017-2018 are a new *Technology and Innovations Room* and enhanced *Early Childhood Classrooms*.

We thank the many parents who have participated in this effort to make our second campus a reality. Your insights and guidance have been invaluable and will continue to help guide us as we continue to look for future opportunities.

"Open to the HOLY SPIRIT "

Some of us have various names. Some of them are religious from our baptism or from a role in the Church. Sometimes affectionate names are given to us by family or friends as a sign of love. Some names are given to point to characteristics we have or are "nick names." Some come from our language, heritage or culture. All of these names say something special about us.

Today we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost. The Holy Spirit is called many names. Some of those names appear today in the sequence prayer just after the second reading. Many of the names point to ways the Spirit acts or speak of the nature of the Holy Spirit. All the titles are prayed asking the Holy Spirit to come to us under these many names. "Father of the poor" indicates the protection and care toward the poor. We are all poor. "Comforter the Best" leads us to open ourselves to the Spirit for comfort. "Grateful coolness in the heat and, "solace in the midst of woe" are also expressions about the action of the Spirit. These titles point to ways the Holy Spirit comes to us in times of suffering. The sequence also requests the Holy Spirit to come and heal us, strengthen us, wash away guilt, change our stubbornness and melt our frozenness. We pray that we will be filled with the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit. We ask the Holy Spirit to "fill us with joy that never ends."

We know we receive the Holy Spirit through the sacraments. The challenge for each of us is to be open to the blessings and gifts the Holy Spirit wants to bring. Pray to the Holy Spirit under the special names used today. Spend time asking. The Holy Spirit is with us and will give us all we need. Just ask and give thanks.
